Case:


- Deborah is non weight bearing and her left leg doesn't flex easily
- Deborah previously used a mobile hoist but it was very demanding on her caregivers
 - Using a mobile hoist for toileting is a multi-step job which is time consuming
 - A mobile hoist requires two caregivers meaning Deborah's parents always had to be available

Solution:

- Changing to the Kera sit2sit means that Deborah can be easily transferred by only one caregiver
- Toileting is really easy with the Kera
- The raised Kera sit2sit is best for navigating Deborah's wheelchair and commode
- The Kera sit2sit was funded by IF/EGL funding and Deborah's parents have given back their mobile hoist
